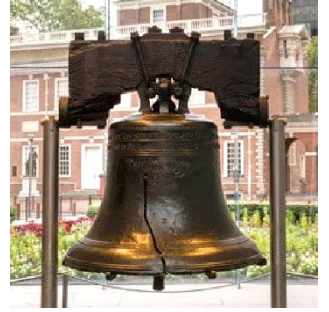

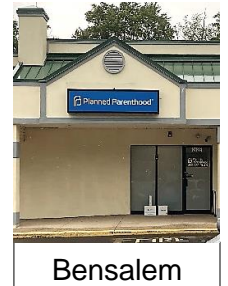
The Mission of the Pro-Life Legal Fund

Since 1986, our organization has effectively advanced the interests of the pro-life movement in court cases and advocated for pro-life public policies at the local, state, and national levels. Our continuing efforts include protecting pro-life sidewalk counseling, protecting the medically vulnerable, resisting transgender tyranny, requiring abortion chambers to comply with child abuse reporting laws, protecting existing and passing new pro-life legislation in Pennsylvania.

Planned Parenthood's Warminster Abortion Chamber Closes Life-Saving Efforts Commence in Bensalem



Planned Parenthood (PP) closed its Warminster abortion chamber on June 27, 2024. Our organization had invested considerable resources into zoning and court cases to seek the closure of this AC and to defend pro-life sidewalk counselors from criminal charges.



However, Bucks County PP is now referring some of its "clients" to their chemical-only abortion chamber in Bensalem. Thus, local pro-life citizens are commencing prayer vigils and sidewalk counseling at this abortion chamber.

PP Bensalem has no sidewalk or grassy walkway, such as at Warminster. So, these efforts have commenced in the parking lot near PP. Based on vast experience, these pro-life citizens can expect the threat of civil action by PP and/or arrest by the Bensalem Police to remove their presence from this parking lot. Our organization intends to vigorously defend the legal rights of these citizens.

Defending Pennsylvania's Medicaid Funding Restrictions



Pa. Medicaid abortion funding restrictions have been annually reducing abortions in our State by 5,000 since they took effect in 1985. In January 2019, Pa.'s then 16 abortion chambers filed a lawsuit requesting that the Pa. Supreme Court declare these restrictions unconstitutional, even though in 1985, by a 6-1 vote, this Court upheld these restrictions.

In January 2024, this Court issued a convoluted and ominous decision in this case. This Court did not yet invalidate these restrictions, but it remanded the case, with bad instructions, to Pa. Commonwealth Court for further consideration.

This January 2024 Pa. Supreme Court decision also removed attorneys for the Pa. House and Senate, who had been vigorously defending these restrictions. Because pro-abortion Gov. Josh Shapiro's Department of Human Services and pro-abortion Pa. Attorney General Michelle Henry are not defending these restrictions, the pro-life side now has no legal representation, as this case again proceeds through the Pa. Commonwealth Court. Thus, our organization's attorneys are filing a petition that seeks standing to defend Pa.'s Medicaid abortion funding restrictions.
